Directions to The Memorial Park:

By New York City Subway:

A, C, J, M, Z, 2, 3, 4 or 5 to Fulton Street: Exit onto Fulton Street & walk west to Church Street.

2 or 3 to Park Place: Exit onto Church Street & walk south.

E to World Trade Center: Exit onto Church Street.

R to Rector Street: Walk north onto Church Street about three blocks.

1 to Rector Street: Exit onto Greenwich Street & walk north to Liberty Street.

By New York City Bus:

Take the M1 or M6 to Church & Vesey Street.
