TKTS Ticket Booth **The Half Price Ticket Stands**

A guide to the Theatre Development Fund's half price Broadway ticket booth "TKTS" that sells half price tickets to Broadway Shows

There are three different TKTS Ticket Booth Locations:

Times Square Booth:

Location:

Redesigned and rebuilt in 2008, the new TKTS booth in Times Square is located "under the red steps" in Father Duffy Square at Broadway and 47th Street. This is the main Broadway discount ticket booth, which is right in the heart of NY City's theater district.

Operating Hours:

On Mondays through Saturdays you can purchase same-day Broadway tickets for evening performances between 3PM and 8PM.

Matinee Tickets:

On Wednesdays and Saturdays you can buy tickets for matinee performances between 10AM and 2PM.

On Sundays, the ticket booth sells matinee tickets from 11AM to 3PM and tickets for evening performances are sold from 3PM until closing.

Length Of Ticket Lines:

The Times Square Broadway TKTS ticket booth gets busy an hour before it opens and the lines can be quite long. You should make sure you allow for enough time. It has a ticket line for "Plays only" which can be significantly shorter.

South Street Seaport:

Location:

Originally located on the mezzanine of the South Tower at the World Trade Center, the downtown TKTS booth is now located at the South Street Seaport. This TKTS discount ticket booth is situated at the corner of Front and John Street (at the rear of the Resnick/Prudential Building at 199 Water Street).

Operating Hours:

The booth is open for ticket sales Mondays through Fridays from 11AM to 6PM, Saturdays from 11AM to 7PM, and Sundays from 11AM to 4PM.

Matinee Tickets:

Matinee tickets for Wednesday matinees are sold only on Tuesdays, and Saturday matinee tickets can only be purchased on Friday. Sunday matinee tickets are sold on Saturdays from 11AM to 4PM.

Length Of Ticket Lines:

Ticket line is shorter than the Times Square TKTS booth but this location is not convenient for anyone already in uptown Manhattan. Its a round trip of over an hour from the theatre district - Great choice for someone who is already downtown.

Downtown Brooklyn:

Location:

Built to cater to Brooklyn locals to encourage them to go into the city, while allowing them to avoid the hassle of the Times Square location. The Downtown Brooklyn TKTS discount ticket booth is located at 1 MetroTech Center at the corner of Jay Street and Myrtle Street Promenade.

Operating Hours:

Tuesday through Saturday:
11AM - 6PM

Matinee Tickets:

Matinee tickets are sold on the day before the performance.

Length Of Ticket Lines:

Usually very short ticket lines.

Notes:

This TKTS booth is clearly not convenient to any of the Broadway theatres as it takes at least 30 minutes to get to the theatre district from this location by subway - one of the reasons why it closes at 6PM. It only appeals to ticket buyers who live close to it.

Broadway RUSH Tickets - **Anyone RUSH**

Many Broadway shows offer discount "Rush" tickets at cheap prices that are also great seats. These discount Broadway tickets are available to anyone, just as long as you arrive early enough with cash in hand at the Broadway theatre. Fans can show up at the theater box office first thing in the morning and buy Broadway show tickets (often the front row for just \$20).

Some Broadway shows distribute Anyone Rush tickets the old-fashioned way, too, by asking ticket buyers to arrive when the theater box office opens in the morning, or at a specific time during the day (we also detail these policies in our Broadway Discount Tickets Guide). Anyone Rush tickets are usually about \$20-\$25 each, but occasionally the tickets are up in the \$30-\$40 range. Remember that you are usually expected to pay for these discount tickets with cash, and often (especially with the lottery) a photo ID is required, as they limit the total amount of discount tickets you can buy on any one day.

Transportation By Subway:

- Take the B (weekdays only) or C to 81st Street. Two blocks west of the Museum, the 1 train stops at Broadway and West 79th Street.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** For the duration of the construction on the Manhattan Bridge the B subway line will not operate on the Upper West Side during the weekends. Weekday service will not be affected during visitor hours, but the B train will stop running weeknights on the Upper West Side at 10:45pm.

By Bus:

- The M79 bus travels east/west on W. 79th Street across Central Park, with a stop next to the Museum on W. 81st Street. Other buses also stop at or near the Museum, including the M7, M10, M11, M86 and M104 buses.

- Parking is available at our facility conveniently located within the museum; enter at 81st Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue. The hours of operation are 8am – 11pm. Rates are as follows:

Guidelines for visiting

Checkroom: All bags are subject to security inspection before entering the Museum. The Museum requires visitors to check backpacks of any size, shopping bags, and bags 11 x 14 inches (28 x 35.5 cm) or larger. The checkroom will not accept laptops or luggage of any size.

Mobility Access: All galleries and facilities are wheelchair accessible. Wheelchairs are available in the checkroom free of charge.

Sketching: Sketching is permitted in the galleries (pencil only) with sketchbooks no larger than 8 1/2 x 11 inches (21.6 x 27.9 cm). No easels, stools, or sketching while sitting on the floor is permitted. If galleries are crowded, guards may ask visitors to stop sketching or writing.

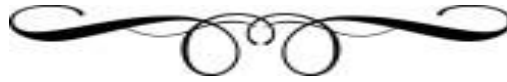
