About The United Nations

The Headquarters of the United Nations (UN) is located along the East River in New York City. This 18-acre site is international territory and belongs to the Organization's 192 Member States. Your visit to the UN begins as you enter the plaza, north of the General Assembly building.

Admission

Prices are applicable to both guided & audio tours:

Adults:	\$16.00
Senior Citizens (60 and older):	\$11.00
Students (with valid ID):	\$11.00
Children (5-12 years old):	\$9.00

For security reasons, children under 5 years of age are not permitted on the tours.

Transportation

It is recommended to use public transportation when visiting the UN Headquarters.

-**By subway:** Numbers 4, 5, 6, or 7 trains to Grand Central Station; walk East on 42nd Street to 1st Ave

-**By bus:** M15, M27, M42, or M104

-**By car:** Private parking garages are available from East 45th Street to East 49th Streets, between 1st and 2nd Avenue.

Security
